Parent Pay

What is Parent Pay?

- ▶ Parent Pay is an online payment system that is used across almost all schools in South Lanarkshire.
- ▶ It allows parents to pay for school related costs at a time and place of their convenience, therefore, avoiding the requirement for cash to be sent into school with the children.
- ▶ The payment system can be used to pay for school dinners, milk, trips, dress down days, tickets for concerts, online fundraisers, PTA fundraisers, school photographs and much more.
- ▶ Payment methods include PayPoint, American Express, debit and credit cards.
- ▶ Please note that children in Primaries 1-5 receive free school meals and parents are not required to pay for their school dinners. Milk is not included within their meal. If you would like your child to have milk with their lunch, there is a cost which should be paid via Parent Pay.



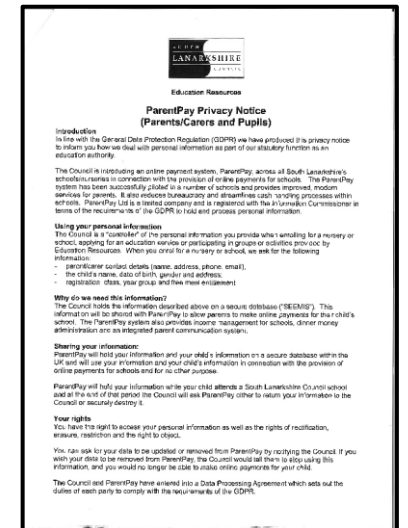
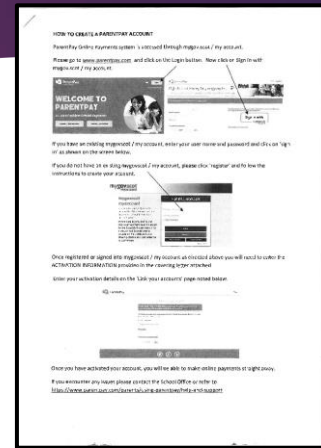
Parent Pay – How do I set this up?

To set up Parent Pay, you will be sent 'account activation details' by our office staff.

These details are generated from the Council system once the children have officially started school in August. It usually takes several days for this to happen.

Once you have activated your account, you will be able to make online payments straight away.
