Our School Uniform – Clothing Grants

You will be entitled to a clothing grant if you are in receipt of any of the following benefits:

- Income support
- Universal Credit (or your earned income is less than £1190 as assessed by the Department Of Work And Pensions in the assessment period immediately preceding your application for a clothing grant)
- Job Seekers Allowance (income based)
- Employment And Support Allowance (Income Related)
- Housing Benefit and / or Council Tax Reduction
- Working Tax Credit and / or Child Tax Credit (where your gross annual income is less than £16105 as assessed by HM Revenues And Customs on your Tax Credit Award Notice TC602)

You will receive a grant for each school aged child in the family. Clothing grants are not available to nursery children.

Our School Uniform – Clothing Grants

- ▶ Clothing grants are paid directly into parent's bank accounts by BACS.
- ▶ In exceptional circumstances, payments are made by cheque.
- ▶ This year, payments will be made from the 9th July.
- ▶ Cheques for clothing grants can be cashed at the Royal Bank Of Scotland, Bank Of Scotland or The Clydesdale Bank.

To cash a cheque at one of these banks, parents will need to take two official forms of identification eg. drivers licence or recent Tax Credit award letter.

Our School Uniform

We like our children to wear their shirt and tie every day, except for their gym days.

You will be notified of our child's gym days when they start school in August.

Ties can be purchased from our office for £3.25 or from the suppliers listed earlier.

Blue shirts and school ties should be worn with grey trousers . Shorts / skirts or pinafores.

Grey cardigans and jumpers embroidered with our school logo are available to buy from the suppliers listed.

There are number of other items that are available from the suppliers. We have attached a leaflet that lets you see what is available.

Indoor Shoes

All children are required to have a pair of indoor shoes that they keep in school and change into when they enter the building.

In Primary 1 the children generally wear traditional black gym shoes or variations of them.

These are fine for using during gym too.



Our School Uniform

- ▶ We love to see our children looking smart in our school blazers! We encourage these to be worn during the better weather but completely understand that the children need something a little warmer for winter.
- ▶ Please ensure that your child's school bag is large enough to hold an A4 wallet. This will be used to keep their homework diary and other materials safe.
- ▶ The most important thing that parents should remember is that **a child's personal items should be clearly labelled with their name.** This includes shoes, ties, jumpers & cardigans, skirts & trousers, gym shoes and gym clothes. Packed lunch boxes and water bottles should also be clearly labelled.
