This is the infant open area. We hang our coats up and change our shoes here.



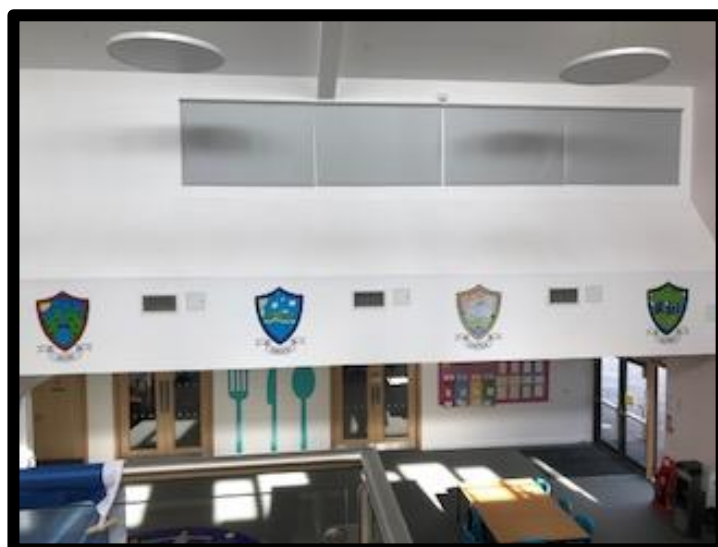
These are our Primary 1 Classes.

see the House Badges.




We are really looking forward to having you in Primary 1. We hope that you will love our school just as much as we do.

We have a healthy tuck shop. Our Primary 6 boys and girls will be in charge of this and it will be in the atrium at playtime.

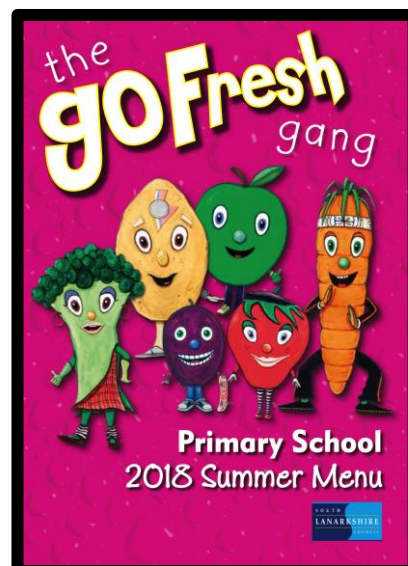


At lunchtime you can have a school dinner or you might want to bring a packed lunch from home.
